Year group themes:

Reception – The moon

The week is planned out through the following:

Rocket Revolution: celebrating the changing world of space launch and the many ways people can explore rocketry today.

Monday: Space workshops for all year groups with AS Creatives coming to school, starting the day with a whole school creative assembly.

Tuesday: Rocket Revolution Day. All year groups learning and creating a whole school immersive display showing rocket development over time.

Wednesday: Visit from Keith Wright for KS2, who worked on the Apollo missions.

Final day for competition projects to be brought in: creating rockets (see dojo for further info).

Thursday: Planetarium visit for all year groups. Finalists will be chosen to show their home competition projects at the space fair. Two children from each class will also be chosen to represent their class learning at the space fair. These children's parents will be notified as they will need to be collected from the main hall after the space fair finishes at approximately 3:45 (see below).

Friday: Mini Professors Space Assemblies for all. Space fair in the school hall in the afternoon.

You are formally invited to our Space Science Fair on Friday 9th October, from 2:30-3:45 in the main school hall.

Please enter the school via the main school office and enjoy wandering through year group stalls to see their projects, investigations and crafts. We will also have the two finalists from each class showcasing their home project creations, with first, second and third place winners chosen for each competition.

You are welcome to visit the fair before pick up time, and visit after school with your children. We hope to see as many of you there as possible!
